

Red Knights are Champs

The BSM girls' soccer team claimed the state Class A title on November 1, defeating the Blake Bears, 3-2, in sudden death at the Metrodome. Last year, BSM lost to Blake in the state championship game, and earlier this season, the two teams finished in a tie. The BSM girls' soccer team has competed at state for seven of the past eight seasons. This is their first championship. Red Knights named to the All-Tournament team were seniors **Anne Arnason, Dana Buckhorn, and Maria Michels.** and junior **Kelly Pannek.** Earlier in the season the *Star Tribune* recognized Buckhorn and Michels as Athletes of the Week, and junior **Kelly Pannek** was listed as one of the "players to watch."



Jack is Back

Junior Jack Jablonski, who was injured in a hockey game last December, is back on campus. Jack completed the studies for his sophomore curriculum and has rejoined his classmates at BSM. Taking an aggressive course load this semester, he puts in a full school day before heading to Courage Center until approximately 5:30 p.m. each week day for physical therapy. With the use of an iPad, voice-recognition software, and shared notes from teachers and fellow students, Jack—with his easy-going personality and witty sense of humor—has adjusted well to his new routine.

The fact that Jack is allowed to leave classes slightly early to navigate hallways with less congestion is perhaps more beneficial to his peers than himself. Jack "is not fragile," explains his physical therapist, but his power chair, weighing several hundred pounds, could cause damage to someone's toes.

On November 11, Jack was featured in a CBS program,

Courage in Sports. The one-hour special recognized individuals who have overcome monumental challenges to achieve greatness in the world of sports. Jack was named the second-annual America's Choice Honoree, after winning a four-week Facebook voting competition on the program's website.

Jack's younger brother, **Max,** also became a Red Knight this year as an 8th grader.

Eight Benilde-St. Margaret's seniors have been recognized by the National Merit Scholarship Program for the 2012-2013 school year. The Red Knights have five National Merit semifinalists and three commended students. BSM's semifinalists are **Catherine Cole, Elizabeth Magill, Kiley Petersen, Amanda Semler** and **Elizabeth Vertina.** Less than one percent of each state's high school seniors qualify as semifinalists, making up approximately 16-thousand nationwide. To become finalists, semifinalists must have outstanding academic records, endorsement from their school principals, and SAT scores that confirm their earlier PSAT results. Finalists in this process will be notified in February. Also being recognized for their exceptional academic promise are a total of about 34-thousand Commended Students throughout the nation. Commended students from BSM are **Anne Arnason, Giulia Imholte** and **Caitlin Sisk.**

INSIDE the Classroom

Instruments of Learning



With a musical instrument in one hand, and a laptop computer in the other, BSM music students are coming to class to experience a new way of interacting with the music curriculum. Smart Music is one of a few types of computer programs that is allowing orchestra and band students to weave technology into their playing. Taking advantage of the microphone on their laptops, students can play music near their computer and receive immediate feedback about their performance, based on the pitch and tempo of the music played. It's the computer equivalent of red-pen corrections on a piece of paper.

At the beginning of band classes, director Paul Keefe may project Smart Music's automatic tuner on a screen in front of the class. Each student will play a note and watch as a dial on the screen registers the pitch of that note. Later on, a sight-reading exercise may challenge students to play an unfamiliar piece of music and be scored on the impromptu performance. Then, at home, students can either play along with a single instrumental track or hear themselves with an entire ensemble. Orchestra teacher Kristina Lantz says, "It's kind of like having a practice buddy." Fingering pop-ups are available, if needed, and sections of songs can be repeatedly looped for drilling difficult spots. With the click of a button, songs can be transposed. Plus, students who miss section rehearsals can log in to Smart Music, which registers their practice time, and they can record their lesson to send to the teacher. Mr. Keefe appreciates being able "to hold kids more accountable," not having to collect papers that parents have signed.

Students in Music Theory class use a similar program, Finale, to write music with the aid of their laptop keyboard. Other applications, including Garage Band and YouTube, are also utilized for sharing examples and tips. According to Mr. Keefe, using technology in the music classroom has "a bright future"...despite any extra weight lifting on the way to class.

Awareness Tour

Students in the Discipleship in Society class took the annual Awareness Tour, an off-campus field trip, to experience and learn about the variety of needs of people in the community surrounding BSM. Kurt Wiger and Courage Center; House of Charity; Sharing and Caring Hands/Mary's Place, led by Mary Jo Copeland (seen here with BSM students); and IOCP (Interfaith Outreach Community Partnership) welcomed the visitors, directed special activities and tours, and talked about economic, physical, emotional, and spiritual issues affecting the people they serve. The students had lunch at the Mercado Central on Lake Street in Minneapolis. When they returned to campus they met **Kenin Conway '75**, who discussed his ministry, Mobile Loaves and Fishes. The students were inspired to find ways they, too, can be socially responsible and serve their community.

Our Spiritual History – BSM’s Charisms

The Benilde-St. Margaret’s mission leads with a statement that we are “a dynamic Catholic learning community which partners with parents/guardians to develop the student’s highest potential in mind, body, and spirit.” Today, BSM is run by non-ordained (i.e., lay) leaders; we are built on the foundation given to us by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, the Christian Brothers, and the Benedictines. We follow the Archbishop of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, and Catholic teaching informs our entire curriculum.

BSM spiritual history guides us to be who we want to be. We are deliberate about, and committed to, manifesting day-to-day the 11 God-given charisms (i.e., character, gifts) that comprise our essence. They are:

To be mindful of God in all the events of our lives
- **Community**
To live in relationship and strive for common good
- **Profound Respect for Persons**
To love all our neighbors without distinction
- **Balance**
To live balanced in spirit, mind and body
- **Stewardship**
To use our resources wisely and prudently
- **Possumus (We Can)**
To trust the Spirit to provide us with the means and the guidance to do what needs to be done
- **Justice**
To work diligently to bring about right relationships
- **Gentleness**
To be kind in holding one another accountable
- **Focus on Students**
To provide a practical, effective and accessible education
- **Hospitality**
To warmly and generously welcome all who enter
- **Stability**
To cultivate rootedness and a shared sense of mission


“We use the image of a legacy tree to highlight those aspects of our founding orders that are very present and alive today at BSM,” said Holly Hoey Germann, vice president of faith formation. “The statements in the tree trunk are deeply rooted in the charisms of, and shared by, our founders. Each founding order claims these five charisms.”

At the root of the legacy tree are the individual religious orders’ charisms that BSM strongly manifests. For example, “Possumus” (We Can) and “Justice” are from the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet, who built St. Margaret’s Academy.

The Christian Brothers, builders of Benilde High School, bring us “Gentleness” and “Focus on Students.”

The gifts of “Hospitality” and “Stability” are given to us by the Benedictines, who became a part of the merged BSM community nearly four decades ago.

“The influence of the charisms of these three founding orders is enormous. When we use the legacy tree imagery and refer to our charisms, it’s in the context of being Catholic and grounded in the gospel message. It’s a way of talking about BSM, our Catholic identity, and our spiritual history. These charisms are part of what sets us apart from other schools in the area.” said Ms. Hoey Germann.

In May 2012, the Benilde-St. Margaret’s Board of Directors completed a comprehensive strategic planning process that involved board members, faculty, staff, parents and alumni over a period of several months. The board adopted BSM 2020, a plan that sets us on a mission-based trajectory toward one goal:

By 2020, BSM will excel as a nationally recognized leader in 21st century, Catholic, college preparatory education, preparing students to live their faith and thrive in a changing world.

In the next several years, BSM will focus on four cornerstones that support our goal:

- 21st Century Academic Excellence
- Developing the Whole Student in a Catholic Community
- Best Teaching and Innovative Instruction
- Invest in BSM’s Future

“These four cornerstones are essential for the future BSM that will be built on a strong foundation – the legacies of St. Margaret’s Academy, Benilde High School and Benilde-St. Margaret’s School,” said Dr. Bob Tift, BSM president. “We are in a strong place today, thanks to the tremendous commitment and contributions of the founding orders, faculty, staff, families, and friends who came before us. Today, we are building the BSM legacy from which future generations of Red Knights will benefit.

The following summary of our cornerstones of the BSM 2020 plan is part of what informs the work going forward.





21st Century Academic Excellence

BSM is a recognized leader in college preparatory education. We prepare students to make a

difference in an ever-increasingly interconnected world. By 2020, our alumni will be challenged by complex problems in jobs that haven't yet been created. Through BSM 2020, we will:

- Create the BSM Center for Innovative Instruction that continually supports and cultivates best teaching and where teachers focus on professional development, innovation and collaboration;
- Leverage technology (e.g., laptop program, video, reversed/"flipped classroom," blended/online learning, real-time international collaboration) for learning;
- Help teachers to research, design, pilot, and refine real-world, applied learning experiences, strengthen best practices, discover "next practices;"
- Serve as a resource for teacher education to the broader Catholic- and area-school networks.



Invest in BSM's Future

BSM attracts families who are seeking a superior Catholic, college preparatory education within a strong, supportive and

caring community. As a Catholic school, we are committed to having a diverse student body and community, welcoming those who support our mission of Catholic education. Through BSM 2020, we will:


