Benilde-St. Margaret's School is a premier Catholic, college preparatory school in the Twin Cities. BSM was founded in 1974 to serve a student body who came primarily from the merger of all-girl St. Margaret's Academy (founded by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet in 1907) and all-boy Benilde High School (founded by the Christian Brothers in 1956). With a typical enrollment around 1,160 students in grades 7-12, students come to BSM from throughout the Twin Cities metropolitan area, including Minneapolis and thirty surrounding suburbs. BSM supports 20% of its student body with tuition assistance totaling nearly \$1.7 million each year.
