## **Benilde-St. Margaret's School Transportation Information For 2019-2020 School Year**

Since students arrive at school each day in many different ways, this information is for everyone and explains the many programs BSM has to assist in the transportation process—be it for car or bus riders.

If you plan to use any of the available bus services next fall, please return the registration form by June 30, 2019 (preferred date—but forms are accepted as received. Several of the buses may fill up, so it would be wise to not postpone sending in your registration.

*Reminder—bus registrations are NOT carried forward from year to year—a new form needs to be completed each year.*

### **Transportation Reimbursement (State Aid)**

This item is very important as it affects nearly every student. A complicated Minnesota state law guarantees equal school bus transportation to all students—public and private—or financial aid as a substitute. The average amount of this financial aid for BSM families is approximately \$200 per student or family depending upon the school district of residence.

The application process has been updated and Form 1000, required by most school districts, is available on the BSM website (click on “Parents” and then click on “Transportation”.) This completed form can then be turned in at Red Knight Roundup on August 12<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. If your school district requires a special form, it will be available in your folder at Red Knight Roundup. You can take care of the necessary paperwork at that time or receive instruction on what steps you will need to follow for application in your school district.

St. Louis Park resident do not receive the aid as buses are provided by the school district. Minneapolis and St. Paul school districts do not participate in the process.

## St Louis Park Public School District

General guidelines—Students will ride from their neighborhood each morning to the St. Louis Park Middle School where they will transfer to a shuttle bus heading for BSM. At regular dismissal time, the students will ride the shuttle bus to the Park Immersion School where they will transfer to their neighborhood buses for the ride home. (PLEASE NOTE: This dismissal shuttle bus **departs** from BSM at **2:45 p.m.**)

There will be a morning and dismissal bus each day of the public school calendar. There is NO late activity bus provided. There is no charge for this service, but you are asked to register your student in order to receive the shuttle bus information. Schedules will arrive from St. Louis Park District bus company about 10 days before school begins.

## BSM Provided School Bus Routes

General Guidelines—In order to keep route ride times short and enable us to cover a larger area, preference is given for a few location stops (i.e. churches, schools and shopping centers.) However, consideration will be given to a neighborhood stop (not a “house” stop) for a group of five (5) or more students who are registered and riding the bus on a regular basis. Please use the “Other” line on the bus registration form and note the requested stop intersection. Mileage between listed stops, ease of getting to/from location, driving time and other variables will be taken into account when reviewing these requests. *Any prior year stops of fewer than five (5) students may be re-evaluated for continued feasibility.*
